WHEREAS, Metro Express, Inc. completed sidewalk and curbing repairs within the Village in Fiscal Year 2005-2006, the Village expended approximately \$43,000 for sidewalk and curbing repairs; and,

WHEREAS, the Village of Palmetto Bay has budgeted an additional \$25,000 to continue repairing existing sidewalk and curbing in Fiscal Year 2005-2006.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The Village Manager is authorized to issue a second purchase order in an amount not to exceed \$25,000 for additional sidewalk and curbing repairs to Metro Express, Inc. pursuant to all of the terms and conditions as authorized by the Village Council in Resolution No. 05-75, dated the 5th day of October, 2005. Contractor shall be required to comply with all performance bond requirements, insurance requirements, and other general and special conditions as identified in the invitation to bid documents.

BACKGROUND AND ANALYSIS

The Village of Palmetto Bay would like to "piggy back" on Miami-Dade County Sidewalk – People's Transportation Plan, Project No. 20030007 bid awarded to Metro Express, Inc. to repair and replace existing sidewalks and curbing throughout the Village and install new sidewalks on an as needed basis. The Village has an ongoing program to repair damaged sidewalks within the right-of-ways, locate missing sidewalks and pedestrian ramps required to meet the American Disabilities Act. Through complaints and visual inspections, sidewalk failures are identified and prioritized for repair or replacement. Small repairs are scheduled and repaired by Village staff. Inspection of work performed is provided by the Village staff to ensure the quality of the completed work.

The Village sidewalk improvement project began in Mid-August of 2004. To date, the Village has expended \$75,000 for new sidewalks, curbing and the repair of existing

sidewalk. The Village of Palmetto Bay has budget \$50,000 for the continued repair and replacement of existing sidewalks throughout the Village in Fiscal Year 2005-2006.

FISCAL/BUDGETARY IMPACT

The Village budget this item under "Special Revenue Fund- LOS Improvements Sidewalks" for an amount not to exceed \$50,000 in the Fiscal Year 2005-2006. Once this item has been procured, the Special Revenue Funds for sidewalk repairs in fiscal year 2005-2006 will be exhausted.





Section 2: This resolution shall take effect immediately upon approval.


