

**RESOLUTION NO. 06-90**

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, REQUESTING OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY PARK AND RECREATION FULL AND CONTINUED DISCLOSURE AND CONDUCT A PROFESSIONAL VIABILITY STUDY OF THE CURRENT AND FUTURE PLANS CONCERNING ESTABLISHMENT OF A WETLANDS AREA FOR BILL SADOWSKI PARK; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Village of Palmetto Bay remains concerned with maintaining the quality of life for residents in our community; and

WHEREAS, the Village became aware of plans to construct a wetlands preserve at Bill Sadowski Park, located within the Village at 17555 SW 79 Avenue, after neighbors reported that about an one-acre of land was being cleared in anticipation of the project; and

WHEREAS, the Village has requested that the Miami-Dade County Park and Recreation Department perform a professional viability study to resolve all concerns regarding the wetland project. To date, the Village has not received a written response.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The Village of Palmetto Bay, Florida, urges the County to perform a professional viability study of the proposed wetlands project at Bill Sadowski Park, 17555 SW 79 Avenue, and additionally advise the Village of current and future plans of this park located within the Village limits. The study should include components as outlined in a July 18, 2006, letter from Mayor Flinn to Miami-Dade Parks and Recreation Director Vivian Donnell-Rodriguez.


