3 **RESOLUTION NO. 07-100**

4 A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE
5 VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA; RELATING TO SURPLUS
6 EQUIPMENT; DECLARING 2000 LAND ROVER, TO BE SURPLUS;
7 AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO DISPOSE OF THE
8 EQUIPMENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THE
9 FLORIDA STATUTES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

10 WHEREAS, on January 5th, 2007, per order of the Circuit Court of the Eleventh Judicial
11 Circuit forfeited to the Miami-Dade Police Department Law Enforcement one(1) Land Rover
12 Vehicle bearing VIN NO: SALTY1249YA277787. The Village of Palmetto Bay obtained the
13 rights to the vehicle as a result of its use in the commission of a felony within the Village Limits.

15 WHEREAS, the Village Council finds and determines that this property is surplus as
16 being obsolete, inadequate or no longer needed for public purposes; and

18 WHEREAS, the property shall be disposed of in accordance with the provisions of the
19 Florida State Statute 274.06.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE
22 COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

24 Section 1. The 2000 Land Rover Vehicle is hereby declared surplus.

26 Section 2. The Village Manager is hereby authorized to dispose of the vehicle in
27 accordance with Florida State Statute 274.06. Any funds received from
28 disposition of this vehicle shall be placed in the Village's
29 contraband/forfeiture fund under 932.701, Florida Statutes, et seq.

31 Section 3. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
