RESOLUTION NO. 07-127

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA; APPROVING THE 2008 STATE LEGISLATIVE AGENDA WHICH SUPPORTS THE PRIORITIES OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Village of Palmetto Bay has been extremely successful in obtaining grant funding through state appropriations in the past; and,

WHEREAS, the Council has developed a Legislative Agenda that supports the priorities of the Village of Palmetto Bay for the 2008 Legislative Session.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. The Village Council hereby approves the 2008 Legislative Agenda in support of the established Village priorities, which shall include maximizing all available appropriation opportunities for Village projects, including but not limited to Thalatta and other Village park initiatives, as well as Village-wide stormwater and other infrastructure public works projects. In addition, the Village Council establishes the priority of co-designating the corridor of US-1 that encompassing the Palmetto Bay boundaries, which extend from S.W. 136 Street south to S.W. 184 Street, as Palmetto Bay Boulevard, lessen the historic restrictions to allow for public funds to be used for enhancements, including much-needed traffic improvements, to Old Cutler Road, as it extends throughout Palmetto Bay, and maximizing seeking funding for historic preservation in Palmetto Bay.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon approval.
