RESOLUTION NO. 07-37

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, SELECTING A NEW NAME FOR S.W. 90 AVENUE BETWEEN SOUTHWEST 164 STREET AND SOUTHWEST 168 STREET; PROVIDING FOR INSTALLATION OF APPROPRIATE SIGNAGE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on November 7, 2005, the Village Council adopted Ordinance 05-12 that established procedures for naming of governmental facilities; and

WHEREAS, the American Legion was chartered by the United States Congress in 1919 as a patriotic, mutual help, war-time veterans organization. The American Legion is a community-service organization that now numbers nearly 3 million members. The Village of Palmetto Bay is proud to be one of the communities with an American Legion hall; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Palmetto Bay is desirous of naming SW 90 Avenue between SW 164 Street and SW 168 Street in honor of the American Legion; and,

WHEREAS, the Village Council desires to give instruction and direction to the Village Manager with regard to carrying out this directive.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Southwest 90 Avenue between SW 164 Street and SW 168 shall be named as follows:

AMERICAN LEGION WAY


Section 2. The Village Manager is instructed to install appropriate markers recognizing the designation of this Park.


