

RESOLUTION NO. 07-55

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS ON SW 148TH STREET IN THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY; APPROVING THE SELECTION OF ACOSTA TRACTOR, INC. TO PROVIDE CONSTRUCTION SERVICES FOR PAVING AND DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS IN THE AREA OF SW 148TH TO THE NORTH, SW 148TH DRIVE TO THE WEST, SW 152ND STREET TO THE SOUTH, AND SW 80TH AVENUE TO THE EAST; AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO APPROVE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS IN AN AMOUNT UP TO \$764,276 CONSISTING OF A BASE BID OF \$534,154 AND AN ADDITIVE BID OF \$230,122; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Village selected Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc., to design a storm water drainage system that will substantially improve the drainage/flooding condition on SW 148th Drive and SW 148th Street, north of SW 152nd Street and west of 80th Avenue in the Village of Palmetto Bay; and

WHEREAS, the Village followed a competitive bid process for SW 148th Street Drainage Improvements Project with the issuance of Invitation to Bid (Bid) #2007-PW-102; and

WHEREAS, the Village received bid responses from eight (8) respondents, based on the bid package requirements; and

WHEREAS, the lowest bidder Budget Construction is non responsive; and

WHEREAS, the bid analysis conducted by Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. and the Village has determined that Acosta Tractors, Inc. has the local experience and reputation for projects of this type to come in on time and within budget; and

WHEREAS, Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. and the Village have determined that Acosta Tractors, Inc. is the lowest responsive/responsible bidder for this municipal roadway/drainage improvements project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The following construction company is hereby selected to provide Storm Water Construction Services for the Village of Palmetto Bay.





Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon approval.



As part of limited post design services for the above referenced project, Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc is to review the bids and prepare a bid tabulation, evaluate the bids using criteria established by the Village, and provide a recommendation of award. On March 27, 2007, a bid tabulation and recommendation of award was provided to the Village. The recommendation was to proceed to contract with the second lowest bidder, Acosta Tractors, Inc. This recommendation was based on the fact that the low bidder and second low bidder submitted bids that were very similar in total cost to the Village, and research and consideration of the award parameters outlined in the Contract Documents (such as references and experience on similar municipal roadway/drainage improvement projects). The research consisted of calling references provide by the bidders.

Upon completion of calls for the apparent low bidder (Budget Construction Co., Inc.), two contacts provided average references and stated that issues existed. The first reference advised the removal of unsuitable fill and the responsibility of the associated costs became an issue that had to be negotiated with the Owner. It was resolved, but it resulted in an average performance reference. The second reference advised the project went well up to a point, but that the contract is now past the proposed completion date. The delays in the project were not the sole responsibility of the contractor, but the contractor contributed to them. The project delays also impacted a Miami-Dade County public event. The third reference provided by the apparent low bidder was not familiar with the project name or location referenced in the bid.

Upon completion of calls for the second lowest bidder (Acosta Tractors, Inc.), all reports were consistent that performance of work, quality of work, compliance with schedule, and adherence to budget are all very good. The general consensus

was the firm focuses on working with the surrounding community during construction, and that they keep their sites clean. I did not receive negative information.

Per the bid form and specifications, Section 16 (Award of Contract) in the Instructions to Bidders advises that items such as similar experience, contractor references, and proposed sub-contractors are to be considered as part of the contract award. The Village, at its sole discretion, shall award the contract based on considerations of responsiveness, responsibility, and qualifications, and the award will be in the best interests of the Project and/or the Village. Both firms have similar experience in Miami-Dade County, but Acosta Tractors' references were superior and are the basis for this recommendation.

I was not able to identify any legal actions between either firm and their clients, and I recommend the Village attorney pursue that research as another consideration of award.







The following Bid Item Notes apply to all Base Bid and Additive Bid items:

1. Bid Item 101-1 is a lump sum pay item for all mobilization costs and also includes the construction of two (2) project signs that shall be displayed at approaches to the project area. The intent is that the signs will be freestanding. The sign shall display on both sides the project name, Village Logo, elected officials, engineer, and contact information. A detail of the sign is included in the plans.
2. Bid Item 102-1 is a lump sum pay item for a Maintenance of Traffic and includes all pedestrian access maintenance. All crosswalks and sidewalks shall remain open and free of obstructions. Temporary painting for roadways and crosswalks shall be maintained throughout the project.
3. Bid Item 110-1 is a lump sum pay item that includes the removal and disposal of all existing asphalt/concrete pavement and soil/planting as required for the project.
4. Bid Item 331-72 includes all costs associated with resurfacing the entire project area upon completion of the entire trench/pavement restoration phase. All asphalt costs associated with the trench/pavement restoration phase shall be included in Bid Items 443-70 and 430-99.
5. Bid Items 425-x includes all costs associated with installing inlets and manholes, modifying/core drilling existing inlets, and all drainage pipe connections per the plans.
6. Bid Items 443-70 and 430-99 includes all costs associated with the trench excavation, protection of trench, management of excavated material, trench backfill and compaction, testing, and asphalt restoration per the plans and details.
7. Bid Item 524-1 includes all costs associated with installing concrete aprons at new and existing catch basins. This bid item shall also include costs associated with retaining walls if required by adjacent grades.
8. Bid Item SR-1 is a lump sum pay item that includes the complete restoration of the swale area impacted by any construction activity adjacent to drainage work including but not limited to pipe culvert, French drain, catch basins, etc. Any swale areas impacted by the contractor outside of drainage work such as asphalt overlay, pavement markings, etc. will be restored by the contractor at no additional cost to the Village. The pay item includes but is not limited to new sod, landscaping, trees, excavation, new fill, grading, irrigation, driveway aprons, mail boxes, fences, pipes, curbs, etc. to an equal or better condition prior to construction. The contractor shall include the costs associated with a preconstruction video to confirm existing conditions. Any damage not confirmed by preconstruction video will be repaired at no additional cost to the Village.
