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RESOLUTION NO. 2010-17

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, RESPECTFULLY REQUESTING THAT MIAMI-DADE COUNTY CO-DESIGNATE THE PORTION OF SW 168 STREET THAT FALLS WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, ESSENTIALLY FROM SW 90 AVENUE TO SW 87 AVENUE AS "PANTHER PARKWAY"; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Perrine Elementary Expressive Arts School is located within the Village of Palmetto Bay, Florida, and is an A+ rated school recently recognized as a "Magnet School of Distinction" by the national organization of Magnet Schools of America (one of only 70 schools nationwide to be so recognized); and

WHEREAS, it remains apparent to all that this excellent school continues to strive under the outstanding direction, commitment, and dedication of its Principal Maileen Ferrer, teachers and staff, not to mention the hard work of its student body; and

WHEREAS, Perrine Elementary Expressive Arts School deserves recognition and thanks for its dedication to maintaining the high quality standards of education in Miami-Dade County and responding to the growing needs of our community.

WHEREAS, in recognition of this outstanding school, the Village Council respectfully asks that Miami-Dade County co-designate the portion of SW 168 Street that fronts the school from SW 87 Avenue west to SW 90 Avenue; and

WHEREAS, SW 168 Street is a Miami-Dade County road and approval from the Miami-Dade Board of County Commission is necessary.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Council respectfully requests that the Miami Dade Board of County Commissioners co-designate the portion of SW 168 Street that falls within the boundaries of the Village of Palmetto Bay, essentially from SW 87 Avenue west to SW 90 Avenue as "Panther Parkway".

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon approval.
