

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-46

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, RESPECTFULLY REQUESTING THAT MIAMI-DADE COUNTY CO-DESIGNATE THE PORTION OF SW 77 AVENUE THAT FALLS WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, ESSENTIALLY FROM SW 136 STREET TO SW 138 TERRACE AS "HURRICANE HIGHWAY"; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE. [Sponsored by Vice Mayor Pariser]

WHEREAS, Howard Drive Elementary School is located within the Village of Palmetto Bay, Florida, and is an A rated school; and

WHEREAS, it remains apparent to all that this excellent school continues to strive under the outstanding direction, commitment, and dedication of its Principal Deanna Dalby, teachers and staff, not to mention the hard work of its student body; and

WHEREAS, Howard Drive Elementary School deserves recognition and thanks for its dedication to maintaining the high quality standards of education in Miami-Dade County and responding to the growing needs of our community.

WHEREAS, in recognition of this outstanding school, the Village Council respectfully requests Miami-Dade County to co-designate the portion of SW 77 Avenue that fronts the eastern boundary of the school from SW 136 Street south to SW 138 Terrace; and

WHEREAS, SW 77 Avenue is a Miami-Dade County road and approval from the Miami-Dade Board of County Commission is necessary.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Council respectfully requests that the Miami Dade Board of County Commissioners co-designate the portion of SW 77 Avenue that falls within the boundaries of the Village of Palmetto Bay, essentially from SW 136 Street south to SW 138 Terrace as "Hurricane Highway".

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon approval.
