

RESOLUTION NO. 08-10

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO SPECIAL EVENTS; SPONSORING THE JUVENILE DIABETES RESEARCH FOUNDATION; AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO DISBURSE AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,000.00; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. (Sponsored by Council Member Shelley Stanczyk and Mayor Eugene P. Flinn, Jr.)

WHEREAS, Diabetes is a chronic, debilitating disease affecting every organ system. While there are two major types of diabetes, Type 1 (juvenile) diabetes strikes children suddenly, makes them dependent on injected or pumped insulin for life, and carries the constant threat of devastating complications; and

WHEREAS, the Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation (JDRF) International is the leading charitable fund provider and advocate of type 1 (juvenile) diabetes research worldwide. The mission of JDRF is to find a cure for diabetes and its complications through the support of research; and

WHEREAS, since JDRF began operating in 1970, more than \$1.16 billion has been provided to juvenile diabetes research; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Palmetto Bay is desirous of supporting this outstanding organization.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Village of Palmetto Bay, Florida, expresses its support of the Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation.


Section 2. The Village Manager is authorized to disburse an amount not to exceed \$1,000 to assist this worthwhile organization.
