

RESOLUTION NO. 08-12

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO FRIENDS FOREVER RESCUE; PROVIDING FOR CONTRIBUTION TO DOG WALK TO PROVIDE SERVICES TO THE VILLAGE'S PERRINE WAYSIDE PARK SCHEDULED FOR MARCH 8, 2008; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. [Sponsored in part by Mayor Eugene Flinn; and in part by Council Person Paul Neidhart].

WHEREAS, in November 2007, the Village of Palmetto Bay re-opened Perrine Wayside Park under the new name of Perrine Wayside Dog Park.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Village Council of the Village of Palmetto Bay and Friends Forever Rescue, Inc. desire to allow Friends Forever Rescue, Inc. to conduct a Dog Walk at the Village's Perrine Wayside Dog Park.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Village Council approves and authorizes the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$500.00 of funds from the Mayor's discretionary account, which funds shall be used to provide a crowd pleaser for the March 8, 2008 dog walk function. The Village Council also approves and authorizes the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$450.00 of funds from Council Person Paul Neidhart's discretionary account to provide police services and defray the cost of renting the pavilion and park for the Friends Forever Rescue event on March 8, 2008.

Section 2. Prior to the event, Friends Forever Rescue shall provide a plan of the event (map), clean up for the event, supply dog-pooper scooper bags for the dogs participating in the event, proof of insurance for the event, and non-crimes affidavit of the principals running the event. Any food concessions shall be held in the parking lot and not in the park, as food can make the dogs more aggressive and cause a clean-up problem. All events or booths associated with the March 8, 2008 dog walk event by Friends Forever Rescue shall be ADA compliant and shall require Village sign-off.


Section 3. All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with the provisions of this resolution are repealed.

Section 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon approval.


