Dear Palmetto Bay Resident or Business,

On Monday, July 4, 2016, the Village of Palmetto Bay will be hosting a special event in commemoration of our nation's Independence Day. The festivities will include games, food and drink concessions, live music, rides, and of course, no 4th of July festivity would be complete without a spectacular fireworks display to complete the evening!

The Village will be closing several affected roads, for public safety reasons, and is making every reasonable effort to minimize negative impacts to our residents and business. Vehicle access and parking around the Palmetto Bay Municipal Center and its immediate surrounding area will be very limited beginning at 11am. Please see road closure information listed below.

- Franjo Road will be closed from SW 180<sup>th</sup> Street to Miami Children's Hospital parking entrance from 11am – 11pm
- E. Guava Street westbound access will not be permitted from S. Dixie Highway from 11am – 11pm
- Parking lot at Hagan Building will be barricaded at the Guava St, US1, and Franjo St from 11am – 11pm
- E. Hibiscus Street eastbound access will not be permitted from S. Dixie Highway from 11am – 11pm
- SW 98 Avenue Road northbound access will not be permitted past E. Indigo Road from 11am – 11pm
- All northbound traffic on Franjo Road will not be permitted past SW 180<sup>th</sup> Street from 11am – 11pm – must turn east
- SW 94<sup>th</sup> Avenue will be closed for vehicular traffic from 11am – 11pm
- The following streets will be barricaded at the junction with SW 94<sup>th</sup> Avenue from 11am – 11pm:
  - SW 176<sup>th</sup> Street
  - SW 177<sup>th</sup> Street
  - SW 178<sup>th</sup> Street
  - SW 178<sup>th</sup> Terrace
  - SW 179<sup>th</sup> Terrace
