Re: FY2016 Budget Surplus

The Managers Monthly Report for April showed a 1.88% expenditure spread which equated to \$270,000 savings. As of May the expenditure spread has increased to 3% which equates to approximately \$400,000 savings. If we do not have any drastic expenditure increases we should have an estimated \$300,000-\$400,000 surplus for the fiscal year 2016.


