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RESOLUTION NO. 09-101

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO CONTRACTS; AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE CORRADINO GROUP, INC. FOR CIVIL ENGINEERING INSPECTION SERVICES AND TO APPROVE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$65,000.00; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in January 2009, the Department of Public Works submitted a total of thirteen (13) transportation projects to the Miami-Dade County Metropolitan Planning Organization (“MPO”) in order to be eligible to receive funding for transportation projects under the State of Florida Department of Transportation stimulus package bill; and,

WHEREAS, eleven (11) of the thirteen (13) projects were identified as eligible projects by the State of Florida Department of Transportation (“FDOT”) and were prioritized at an MPO emergency meeting held on February 20, 2009; and

WHEREAS, The Corradino Group was authorized per resolution No. 09-23 to provide traffic engineering and transportation planning for two (2) of the eleven (11) eligible transportation projects submitted by the Village of Palmetto Bay to FDOT; and

WHEREAS, in order to meet the strict timelines of the stimulus bill the Public Works Department recommended the selection of the Corradino Group to develop a design-build Request for Proposal and prepare conceptual plans consistent with the May 2009 traffic calming report; and,

WHEREAS, on September 17, 2009 the Village of Palmetto Bay received authority from FDOT to proceed with the terms of the LAP Agreement; and,

WHEREAS, a competitive bid process was followed for design-build services for traffic calming with the issuance of Request for Proposal No. 2009-PW-101-2 and for pedestrian crosswalk improvements with the issuance of Request for Proposals No. 2009-PW-102-2; and,

WHEREAS, once an engineering firm/contractor is selected for the design-build project the Village of Palmetto Bay will be required to contract an engineer for Civil Engineering Inspection services because of the stringent reporting procedures required for the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (“ARRA”); and,

WHEREAS, The Corradino Group is an accomplished firm and has been pre-qualified to provide civil engineering services for the Village of Palmetto Bay.
