
## 1 RESOLUTION NO. 2010-65 2 3 A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF 4 THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO 5 PARKS AND RECREATION; APPROVING THE PROPOSED ENTRY 6 REDESIGN FOR THALATTA PARK AS PROVIDED 7 ATTACHMENT A, WHICH FUNDS HAVE BEEN ALLOCATED AND 8 APPROVED VIA RESOLUTION 2010-59; AND PROVIDING FOR AN 9 EFFECTIVE DATE. 10 11 WHEREAS, the Village of Palmetto Bay is in the process of developing Thalatta Park 12 from a private residential property to a usable public park that will support special events and 13 functions similar to the neighboring Charles Deering Estate; and 14 15 WHEREAS, as we approach completion of the initial construction phase, it is our desire 16 to further enhance the new facility with a specific redevelopment program which will effectuate a 17 unique venue for weddings, special events and private functions; and 18 19 WHEREAS, additional enhancement which were not included in the original scope of 20 work have been identified as necessary to make this facility stand poised to become the premier 21 event locale in South Florida; and 22 23 WHEREAS, this enhancement includes the redesign and improved ingress/egress 24 including additional parking spaces and a grand entry expected of this magnificent facility; and 25 26 WHEREAS, the proposed work is part of the project budget approved by the Village 27 Council via Resolution 2010-59. 28 29 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE 30 COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS: 31 32 The entry redesign for Thalatta Park as proposed on Attachment A, and 33 as approved as part of the project budget, is hereby approved. 34 35 Section 2. A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO PARKS AND RECREATION; APPROVING THE ATTACHED CHANGE ORDER REQUEST WITH PORTLAND CONSTRUCTION FOR THE THALATTA PARK PROJECT; AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE CHANGE ORDER IN THE AMOUNT OF \$84,231.20; APPROVING THE PROJECT BUDGET AND RELATIVE EXPENSES FOR SITE WORK; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Village of Palmetto Bay has been in the process of developing Thalatta Park from a once private residential property to a usable public park that will support special events and functions similar to the neighboring Charles Deering Estate; and

WHEREAS, as we come to the near completion of the initial construction phase, it is our desire to further enhance the new facility with a specific redevelopment program which will effectuate a unique venue for weddings, special events and private functions; and

WHEREAS, additional enhancements which were not included in the original scope of work have been identified as necessary to make this facility stand poised to become the premier event locale in South Florida; and

WHEREAS, these enhancements includes the installation of a flat roof structure to cover the north terrace and an improved ingress/egress including additional parking spaces and a grand entry expected of this magnificent facility; and

WHEREAS, a detailed breakdown of the additional scope of work has been submitted by Portland Construction as Change Request No 7 for the amount of \$84,231.20, and included hereto as Exhibit 1.

WHEREAS, an overall project budget was approved for the reconstruction of the carriage house as part of Resolution No. 09-47, and similarly, an overall project budget for the proposed site-related work is attached as Exhibit 2 for approval; and,

WHEREAS, available funding realized through savings in other project areas and other capital projects as provided on the attached budget are to be reallocated to fund the proposed site-related work at Thalatta Park; and,

WHEREAS, funding for the project includes available grant funding previously approved by the Council, Parks Capital allocations and Suntrust loan funding.
