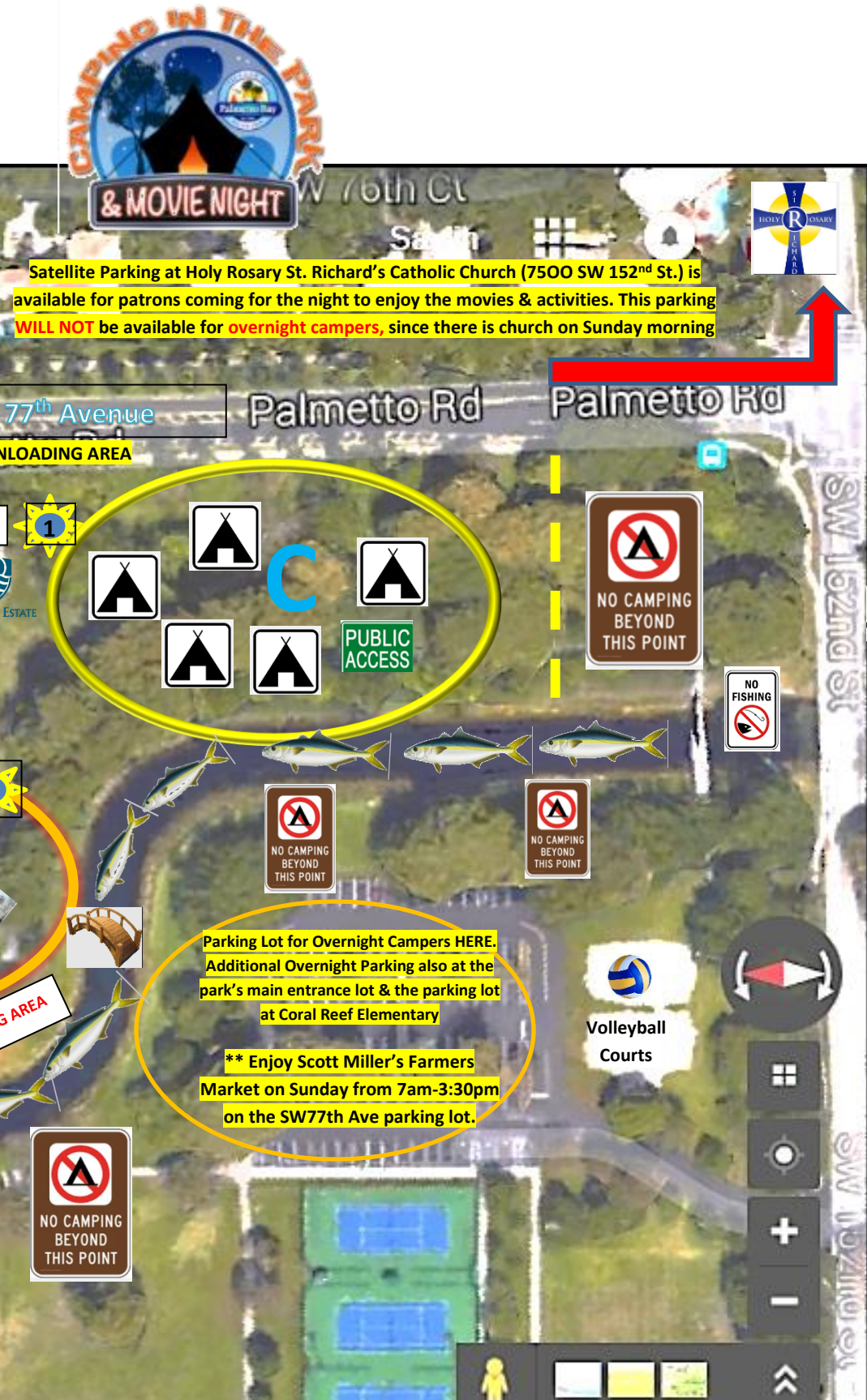


Camping in the Park & Movie Night 2022

VERY IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS: Patrons wishing to camp overnight, must pre-register before the **DEADLINE: Thursday, February 3, 2022** or registration will close once capacity is reached. You will be emailed specific instructions regarding unloading, parking, site map, and schedule of activities by no later than Thursday, February 3rd. All overnight campers may start to set-up their campsite areas between 10:00am-3:30pm on Saturday and must have their campsite setup complete before 4pm. All overnight campers will unload all their items FIRST on the swale areas along SW 77th Avenue, and then immediately move to park their vehicle(s) inside Coral Reef Park parking lots (by tennis & volleyball courts) or the parking lot at Coral Reef Elementary School. You MAY NOT leave your car parked on the SW 77th Avenue swale (west side), as this serves as the unloading/loading designated areas for campers. Patrons who just wish to join us for the evening movies and other schedules activities during the day, may park at Holy Rosary St. Richard Catholic Church. **Overnight campers WILL NOT be permitted to park at the church due to Sunday mass.** We highly recommend that you download the FREE App "REMIND" and join class @pbcamp2022 for important updates and special announcements.
