A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO THE BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN MASTER PLAN; APPROVING THE SELECTION OF THE CORRADINO GROUP, INC., TO UPDATE THE VILLAGE’S BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN MASTER PLAN; AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AN AGREEMENT AND ISSUE A PURCHASE ORDER IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THIRTY-NINE THOUSAND DOLLARS WITH ZERO CENTS (\$39,000.00); AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. *(Sponsored by Administration)*

WHEREAS, the Village of Palmetto Bay adopted its Bicycle and Pedestrian Master Plan in 2009; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the plan was to provide an alternative to car travel and improve connectivity within the Village; and

WHEREAS, over the last thirteen years, traffic conditions have significantly changed in the Village largely due to the substantial growth occurring in areas south of Palmetto Bay; and

WHEREAS, the Village desires to update the existing thirteen-year-old plan to consider the new traffic environment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. The Village Council authorizes the Village Manager to negotiate a contract with The Corradino Group, Inc. for an amount not to exceed \$39,000 to update the Bicycle and Pedestrian Master Plan.

Section 2. This Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its adoption.
