## Howard Drive Walking Path Map

- We encourage you to park near Coral Reef Park/Holy Rosary St. Richard Catholic Church and walk over to the entrance of Howard Drive Elementary School for the Howard Drive Path walk activity. Please bring your refillable water bottle. The round-trip distance, if you park near Coral Reef Park and walk over to Howard Drive Elementary School to participate in the path walk activity, is ~ **6 miles**.
- If you decide to drive and meet up at the entrance of Howard Drive Elementary School, parking is available along the street. The total distance for the Howard Drive Path Walk is **4 miles**.
