RESOLUTION NO. 2022-19

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING SHUTTLE BUS IN-KIND SERVICES FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SERVICES FOR THE DEERING ESTATE APRIL 10, 2022, ANNUAL SEAFOOD FESTIVAL, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000.00), AND POLICE OFF-DUTY SERVICES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED EIGHT THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$8,000.00); AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County Deering Estate at Cutler has requested in-kind services for the use of two (2) Palmetto Bay Buses from the Village of Palmetto Bay Department of Public Services, Division of Transit Operations for their April 10, 2022, Annual Seafood Festival event; and

WHEREAS, the request for the use of two (2) Palmetto Bay Buses, including drivers, to shuttle guest from the Palmetto Bay Village Center and Westminster Christian to the Deering Estate Visitor Center Parking lot is due to the number of attendees; and

WHEREAS, the cost to the Village shall not exceed \$1,000.00, including the cost of fuel; and

WHEREAS, due to the size and nature of this even, a Sergeant and ten (10) off-duty police are being requested for the safety of the guests in an amount not to exceed \$8,000.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Village Council of the Village of Palmetto Bay hereby authorizes in-kind services for use of two (2) buses including drivers as follows: one (1) bus to shuttle guests from Palmetto Bay Village Center and one (1) bus to shuttle guests from Westminster Christian to the Deering Estate Visitor Center Parking lot for the Annual

5 hereby authorizes police off-duty services as follows: one (1) Sergeant
6 and ten (10) off-duty police officers from 8:00am to 8:00pm for the Annual
7 Deering Seafood Festival being held Sunday, April 10, 2022, for an
8 amount not to exceed \$8,000.00.
