A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO DIVISION 30-160, ART-IN-PUBLIC PLACES (“AIPP”) PROGRAM, ACCEPTING THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE AIPP ADVISORY BOARD TO ACCEPT THE ART IN PUBLIC PLACE ARTWORK PROPOSED BY ARTIST MICHAEL SZABO, FROM SZABO WORKS, TO INSTALL THE ART PIECE NAMED “BLOOM” AT THE FRANJO ROAD TRAFFIC CIRCLE LOCATED ON SW 181ST TERRACE AND SW 97TH AVENUE, PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA; AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE. *(Sponsored by Administration)*

WHEREAS, on October 1, 2007 the Mayor and Village Council established the Art-in-Public Places Program (“AIPP”) via Ordinance 07-05, designed to promote the general welfare by encouraging pride in the community, increasing property values, enhancing the quality of life through artistic opportunities, uniting the community through shared cultural experiences, and creating a cultural legacy for future generations through the collection and exhibition of high-quality art pieces that reflect diverse styles, chronicling history through the collection of artifacts, documents and memorabilia that will acknowledge the past and create programs and activities that will further these goals; and

WHEREAS, as part of the responsibilities of the Village of Palmetto Bay’s Code Division 30-160, Art-in-Public Places (“AIPP”) Advisory Board, the Franjo Road Traffic Circle Call to Artist was advertised in the Spring of 2021 on Café.com and received over ninety (90) proposals; and

WHEREAS, the AIPP Advisory Board then summoned a shortlist of four (4) final artists to produce a maquette sample for their proposed art piece and were each paid a \$1,500 stipend; and

WHEREAS, on January 20, 2022, the AIPP Advisory Board both narrowed down their search with selected artists and conducted their Call to Artist Presentations via virtual GotoWebinar; and

1 **WHEREAS**, the AIPP Advisory Board selected Michael Szabo
2 as the artist to install a sixteen foot 16’ art piece called “Bloom”, which
3 is intended to inspire residents and visitors to the community to
4 communicate; and

6 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to 30-160, the associated cost of the art
7 piece on Franjo Road Circle is \$125,000.00, which meets the
8 budgeted amount of the Call to Artist; and

10 **WHEREAS**, the AIPP Advisory Board recommends the Village
11 Council, pursuant to Section 30-160, to accept the proposed artwork.

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND**
14 **VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY,**
15 **FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**

17 **Section 1.** The Mayor and Village Council hereby accept the
18 recommendation of the Art-In-Public-Places Advisory Board to accept
19 the proposed application.

21 **Section 2. Effective Date.** This resolution shall take effect
22 immediately upon approval.
