A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, REGARDING PARKS AND RECREATION; DIRECTING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO ASCERTAIN THE COST TO CONVERT THE EXISTING RACQUETBALL COURTS AT CORAL REEF PARK INTO PICKLEBALL COURTS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Pickleball is a sport that combines the elements of badminton, tennis, and table tennis, and becoming a popular sport since its inception in the mid-nineteen sixties; and

WHEREAS, players use a solid paddle to hit a perforated polymer ball over a net, and is played on a reduced size tennis court, and can be played both indoors and outdoors; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council wishes to have the Village Manager ascertain the cost of converting the existing racquetball courts at Coral Reef Park into pickleball Courts.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the above recitals are incorporated as if set forth in full.

Section 2. That the Village Manger is directed to ascertain the cost to convert the existing racquetball courts at Coral Reef Park into pickleball courts.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon approval.
