

**RESOLUTION NO. 2022-48**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA AMENDING RESOLUTION 2021-105 RELATING TO A WELL ABANDONMENT GRANT; AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO DEVELOP PROGRAM GUIDELINES AND REQUIREMENTS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE. (Sponsored by Mayor Karyn Cunningham)**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Palmetto Bay has signed on to the Resiliency 305 Program; and

**WHEREAS**, one of the recommendations of the program is to abandon wells and connect to a public water system; and

**WHEREAS**, to help the Mayor and Village Council unanimously passed Resolution 2021-105 directing the Manager to create a well abandonment grant; and

**WHEREAS**, the residents residing on Southwest 143rd Street, between 87<sup>th</sup> Avenue and 88<sup>th</sup> Avenue provided reports from the Florida Department of Health identifying a more urgent health and safety concern regarding their drinking water and highlighted that water mains are not present and will need to be extended to be able to abandon their wells.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1:** The above whereas clauses are incorporated as if set forth in full and 2021-105 is amended to incorporate the actions below.


**Section 2:** The Village Manager is hereby authorized to spend up to \$150,000 of ARPA (American Rescue Plan Act) funding to begin the scope of work necessary to immediately provide water mains to the area of 143<sup>rd</sup> Street between 88<sup>th</sup> and 87<sup>th</sup> Avenue so as to provide a more affordable option for those homes to connect to safe drinking water.

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**Section 3:** The Village Manager is hereby authorized to develop and plan and guidelines moving forward for other areas of the Village that have residential homes on well water and to present that plan and the cost to the Mayor and Village Council.


**Section 4:** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon enactment.
