

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-51

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A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO DIVISION 30-160, THE ART-IN-PUBLIC PLACES (“AIPP”) PROGRAM; ACCEPTING THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE AIPP ADVISORY BOARD TO ACCEPT THE ART IN PUBLIC PLACE ARTWORK PROPOSED BY ANDRES GARCIA VELEZ, LOCATED AT 9730 EAST FERN STREET AS THE ART IN PUBLIC PLACE COMPONENT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE HOSPICE CARE UNIT DEVELOPMENT. *(Sponsored by Administration)*

WHEREAS, on October 1, 2007 the Mayor and Village Council established the Art-in-Public Places Program (AIPP) via Resolution 07-05, designed to promote the general welfare by encouraging pride in the community, increasing property values, enhancing the quality of life through artistic opportunities, uniting the community through shared cultural experiences, and creating a cultural legacy for future generations through the collection and exhibition of high-quality art pieces that reflect diverse styles, chronicling history through the collection of artifacts, documents and memorabilia that will acknowledge the past and create programs and activities that will further these goals; and

WHEREAS, Candela + Partners, LLC has selected Andres Garcia Velez, for a design proposal for the incorporation of a fountain for the OpusCare hospice care unit approved by Administration; and

WHEREAS, the construction value of the property at 9730 East Fern is approximately Three Million Six Hundred Sixty-Two Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy-Four Dollars (\$3,662,774.00) with a minimum AIPP requirement of One and One Quarter Percent (1.25%) up to a maximum of Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000.00); and

WHEREAS, the proposed art in public place component is composed of a fountain that is recognized as a peaceful reflection center for visitors of the hospice care unit; and

WHEREAS, on April 14, 2022, the AIPP Advisory Board reviewed the submitted design and asked the artist to provide a more

1 detailed proposal to ensure compliance with Section 30-160; and

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3 **WHEREAS**, on May 3, 2022, the AIPP Advisory Board
4 recommended and approved the proposed design; and

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6 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to 30-160, the AIPP associated cost of the
7 fountain is valued at Seventy-Three Thousand Four Hundred Forty-
8 Two Dollars and Eleven Cents (\$73,442.11) and therefore, meets the
9 AIPP contribution.

12 **VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY,**
