A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO PREPARE AND ISSUE A COMMUNITY SURVEY OF AFFECTED RESIDENTS NOT CONNECTED TO THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY WATER AND SEWER DEPARTMENT'S WATER MAINS AS THEY PRESENTLY DO NOT HAVE THEM ABUTTING THEIR RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY; FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO REPORT THE RESULTS OF THE COMMUNITY SURVEY BY OCTOBER 2022; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE. (Sponsored by Mayor Karyn Cunningham)

WHEREAS, in an effort to access the needs and wants of our Village residents who are not connected to the Miami-Dade County's Water and Sewer water mains as they do not have water mains abutting their property, the Village Council is desirous of conducting a community survey to identify the needs of residents; and

WHEREAS, the Village Manager is directed to prepare and issue the community survey and report back to the Village Council the results of the community survey no later than October 2022; and

WHEREAS, if implemented, per statute, the residents will be required to connect to the water mains within ninety (90) days of their installation and acceptance by MDWASD (absent other exemptions obtained by the individual or the Village); and

WHEREAS, the cost to connect to the new water services will be at the cost of the residents, is estimated to be in the Ten Thousand (\$10,000) Dollar to Twelve Thousand (\$12,000) Dollar range per household; and

WHEREAS, the costs of the conducting the survey will be no more than Twenty-Five Thousand (\$25,000) Dollars.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. The Village Manager is hereby authorized to conduct a community survey of residents who do not have water mains abutting their properties and who are not connected to water mains of the Miami-Dade County Water and Sewer Department and report back to the Village Council by October.

Section 2. This Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its adoption.
