A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, RELATED TO VILLAGE-WIDE TRAFFIC CALMING IMPROVEMENTS, APPROVING THE RECOMMENDATIONS MADE BY MARLIN ENGINEERING, INC. FROM THEIR TRAFFIC STUDY CONDUCTED FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2021-2022; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. (Sponsored by Councilmember Patrick Fiore)

WHEREAS, speeding has become an increasingly alarming issue for residents and the Village of Palmetto Bay continues to be committed to safety and livability of its residential neighborhoods; and
