

Manager's Report

FINANCE

January

- The expenditures in January 2024 were \$ 789,458, 3.62% of the total budget, compared to budgeted expenditures of \$1,816,316, a surplus of 4.71% for the month. Please note that this analysis is based on a straight-line allocation of the budget for the year, which is \$1,816,316 or 8.33% per month. This does not consider the timing of expenditures such as Police, which is billed quarterly, annual bond payment or seasonal events such as Summer Camp or Village events.
- YTD the Village has spent \$ 3,525,067 or 16.17% compared to budgeted expenditures of \$ 7,265,264 or 33.32%.
