

Manager's Report

FINANCE

December

- The expenditures in December 2023 were \$ 1,510,191, 6.93% of the total budget, compared to budgeted expenditures of \$1,816,316, a surplus of 1.40% for the month. Please note that this analysis is based on a straight-line allocation of the budget for the year, which is \$1,816,316 or 8.33% per month. This does not consider the timing of expenditures such as Police, which is billed quarterly, annual bond payment or seasonal events such as Summer Camp or Village events.
- YTD the Village has spent \$2,733,910.35 or 12.54% compared to budgeted expenditures of \$5,448,948 or 25.00%. The first quarter Police invoice for \$2,906,182 has not been paid, which represents 13%.
