A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING THE EFFORTS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY TO SEEK FUNDING FROM THE STATE OF FLORIDA TO CONNECT EXISTING TRAILS THROUGHOUT THE SOUTH-DADE COMMUNITY; AND, PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. (Sponsored by Mayor Eugene Flinn)

WHEREAS, the Miami-Dade County Commission, through the sponsorship of Commissioner Rebeca Sosa, has drafted a Resolution that serves to direct Miami-Dade County's Mayor or his designee to petition the State of Florida Greenways and Trails Council for funding through the State Transportation Trust Fund to connect existing trails in South Miami-Dade County, which includes the municipalities of Cutler Bay, Pinecrest, South Miami, Coral Gables, Miami, Key Biscayne, and the Village of Palmetto Bay; and,

WHEREAS, Palmetto Bay is supportive of this effort.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:



RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE MAYOR OR MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO SEEK A FAVORABLE RECOMMENDATION FROM THE FLORIDA GREENWAYS AND TRAILS COUNCIL FOR STATE FUNDING THROUGH THE STATE TRANSPORTATION TRUST FUND TO CONNECT THE EXISTING TRAILS IN CUTLER BAY, PALMETTO BAY, PINECREST, SOUTH MIAMI, CORAL GABLES, MIAMI, AND KEY BISCAZYNE AND THE PROPOSED UNDERLINE AND LUDLAM TRAILS.

WHEREAS, the Florida Greenways and Trails Council (FGTC) was established pursuant to Florida Statute 260.0142; and

WHEREAS, the duties of the FGTC include advising the Florida Department of Environmental Protection on greenway and trail related issues, promoting intergovernmental cooperation and private partnerships for developing the greenways and trails system, recommending priorities for critical links in the system, and providing funding recommendations for developing and managing the system; and

WHEREAS, connecting the existing trails within Cutler Bay, Palmetto Bay, Pinecrest, South Miami, Coral Gables, Miami, and Key Biscayne with the proposed Underline and Ludlam Trails would reduce congestion and promote alternative fuel efficient modes of transportation,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board directs the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to seek a favorable recommendation from the FGTC for State funding through the State Transportation Trust Fund to connect the existing trails in

Cutler Bay, Palmetto Bay, Pinecrest, South Miami, Coral Gables, Miami, and Key Biscayne and the proposed Underline and Ludlam Trails.
