

Manager's Report

FINANCE

August

- The expenditures in August 2024 were \$ 811,536, 3.72% of the total budget, compared to budgeted expenditures of \$1,816,316, a surplus of 4.16% for the month. Please note that this analysis is based on a straight-line allocation of the budget for the year, which is \$1,816,316 or 8.33% per month. This does not consider the timing of expenditures such as Police, which is billed quarterly, annual bond payment or seasonal events such as Summer Camp or Village events.
- YTD the Village has spent \$16,982,315 or 77.92% compared to budgeted expenditures of \$ 19,979,476 or 91.66%.
