INFORMATION REGARDING POLITICAL SIGNS

Division 30-90. Sign Regulations

Section 30-90.10 Signs Permitting Without a Sign Permit:

- (a)(15) Temporary political campaign signs announcing the candidacy of a candidate for public office not exceeding 620 square inches in size in residential zoning districts and six square feet in area in all other zoning districts. Setback and location shall be at least five feet from the official right-of-way and five feet from property under different ownership. Only one political campaign sign, per candidate, per street face is permitted. Political signs may be installed 90 days prior to the election. Temporary political campaign signs shall be removed within seven days after the last election or within seven days of withdrawal of a candidate from running for elected office. If such signs are not removed within this period of time, the village may remove such signs and may charge the candidate the actual cost for such removal. Failure to remove signs is a violation of this Code and is enforceable pursuant to the village's code enforcement ordinance.
