8 SMALL BOULDER PLAY STRUCTURE AT CORAL REEF PARK
9 PLAYGROUND; AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO
10 APPROVE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO
11 EXCEED \$ 22,649.00; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE
12 DATE. (Sponsored by Administration)

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14 WHEREAS, Resolution 2016-01, passed and adopted January 4, 2016, authorized the
15 naming of the Coral Reef Park Playground to the Bridget Allison Pier Playground; and

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17 WHEREAS, in an effort to establish a specific amenity within the playground which
18 appropriately honors and illustrates recognition as this being the Bridget Allison Pier
19 Playground; and

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21 WHEREAS, the procurement of a Majestic Mountain Boulder, which subsequently
22 will incorporate signage to identify the facility as the Bridget Allison Pier Playground, is deemed
23 to be in the Village's best interest in accomplishing the desire naming objectives; and

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25 WHEREAS, the quote as proffered by Dynamo Industries is considered to be in
26 keeping with the Village's Procurement Policies and Procedures with pricing based on
27 piggybacking RFP No. 13/14-8 Various Equipment and Amenities for Parks and Playgrounds
28 for Clay County, Florida, which pricing is believed in good faith to be pursuant to a
29 competitive bid process; and

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31 WHEREAS, the Mayor and Village Council may authorize the Village Manager to
32 expend up to \$22,649.00 for the purchase, delivery and installation of the a Majestic Mountain
33 Boulder play structure for Coral Reef Park.

40 Coral Reef Park.



43 procurement procedures for this purchase.



3 adoption.





If the purchaser discovers within this period a failure of the product to conform to specifications, or a defect in material or workmanship, the purchaser must promptly notify Manufacturer in writing within fifteen (15) days of discovering the defect. Within a reasonable time after notification, at the sole option of Manufacturer, Manufacturer shall perform a repair or correct these products if defective in manufacturing workmanship, materials or parts only, labour is excluded. Dynamo additionally offers a Ten-year limited warranty against structural failure due to natural deterioration or manufacturing defects.

4. Damage resulting from vandalism.
5. Damage resulting from natural catastrophic events.
6. Normal expected wear or weathering such as colour changes, minor scratches, minor chipping or normal weather-related stains.
7. Efflorescence as a natural curing by-product of GFRC.
8. Accidents, injuries or liabilities which result from the use of Products or services.
9. Damage caused during shipment.
10. Damage which results from incorrect installation that does not conform to published instructions and specifications.

This warranty period of 1 year begins on the date that Products are shipped. The warranty starting and ending dates do not coincide with payment dates or the completion of work done by others. Warranty is void if sand or pea gravel safety surfacing is used as a resilient surface under products. NOTE: All concrete has naturally occurring hairline cracks and these are not product defects.

These warranties cover either replacement or repair, at the Manufacturer's discretion, of any Products according to the above descriptions. Transportation and installation-on-site costs are not covered by these warranties, except where specific arrangements are made with written consent from the Manufacturer.

7 EFFECTIVE DATE. (Sponsored by Mayor Eugene Flinn and Councilwoman

10 WHEREAS, on May 13, 2004, Bridget Allison Pier was born at Baptist Hospital in Miami.
11 Bridget was a healthy and happy child, a great little sister, loving daughter, and a loyal friend; and,

13 WHEREAS, doctors believe that Bridget may have been born with a heart valve condition,
14 a bicuspid valve, that never exhibited any symptoms of trouble until she contracted a bacterial
15 infection called Endocarditis that attacks the interior lining of the heart. On June 29, 2011, while
16 vacationing with her family in Hawaii, following a day of fun and surfing, this lovely little girl
17 tragically and suddenly suffered a massive stroke when the infection's "vegetation" broke free of her
18 heart and traveled to her brain, which resulted in her untimely death on July 3, 2011; and

20 WHEREAS, when it became apparent that doctors would be unable to save her, Bridget's
21 family made the difficult decision to give the Gift of Life. Bridget donated her kidneys to two
22 fortunate people, one cornea was successfully transplanted, and her liver went to medical research in
23 an effort to save countless others. This type of gift would be completely in line with Bridget's way
24 of life. She was a kind, fun child who always made an effort to welcome new students, fiercely loyal
25 to those she loved, and cared deeply for those less fortunate. Her positive attitude, spirit, and desire
26 to learn remain an example of all of us as to how we should live our lives; and

27 WHEREAS, on November 7, 2005, the Village Council adopted ordinance no 05-12
28 relating to naming, re-naming and co-designating village facilities, parks, etc.; and,

30 WHEREAS, pursuant to the ordinance, the Village Council may name a site after a person
31 or persons who have made significant contributions to the community, thereby furthering the
32 Village's good name and image; and,
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34 WHEREAS, the Village Council desires to name the playground at Coral Reef Park, 7895
35 SW 152 Street, in memory of Bridget Allison Pier for her significant contributions.

37 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE
38 COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

40 Section 1. Pursuant to the requirements of Ordinance number 05-12, the Village
41 Council finds that a significant contribution has been made to the Village and the community; and
42 furthermore, the Council agrees that the Playground at Coral Reef Park, 7895 SW 152 Street, shall
43 be, after public hearing and input, officially named the BRIDGET ALLISON PIER
44 PLAYGROUND. Appropriate signage shall be installed.
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1 Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon approval.
