1 **RESOLUTION NO. 2016-117** 2 3 A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE COUNCIL OF 4 THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA; RELATING TO 5 PAID PARENTAL LEAVE FOR EMPLOYEES; AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO ENACT A PAID PARENTAL 6 7 LEAVE POLICY FOR VILLAGE OF PALMETTO 8 EMPLOYEES; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 9 (Sponsored by Councilmember Karyn Cunningham) 10 WHEREAS, the Mayor and Village Council for the Village of Palmetto Bay (the 11 "Village") share a commitment to improving workplace opportunities for working families in 12 the Village's government, and a Paid Parental Leave policy fortifies this commitment; and 13 14 15 WHEREAS, the Village has outstanding employees working with passion and diligence to ensure that we remain the premiere Village in which to live, work, learn, and play; and 16 17 WHEREAS, under federal and state law, eligible employees are entitled to take up to 18 twelve weeks for leave for the birth, adoption or foster placement of a child. During that period, 19 employee's jobs are protected, and they continue to receive employer paid health benefits; 20 21 however, there is no requirement that employees be paid during the leave; and 22 WHEREAS, the lack of income during periods of parental leave puts an undue burden 23 on families and causes employees to return to work earlier than they might otherwise choose to; 24 25 and 26 WHEREAS, paid leave and workplace flexibility increase productivity, help recruit 27 talented workers, lower worker turnover and replacement costs, reduce absenteeism, and 28 29 improve job satisfaction. 30 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE 31 COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS: 32 33 Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this 34 35 reference. 36 Section 2. The Village Manager is hereby directed to develop within a reasonable time, 37 a recommended Paid Parental Leave Policy, including grandparent rights, that provides the 38 Village of Palmetto Bay employees a parental leave benefit that compliments current and future 39 Village benefit offerings, for later consideration by the Village Council. 40 41 Section 3.
