15 **ST.; AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO ENTER**
16 **INTO A CONTRACT AGREEMENT FOR SAME AND ISSUE A**
17 **PURCHASE ORDER IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED**
18 **\$60,000; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**
19 (Sponsored by Administration)

20
21 **WHEREAS**, marked bicycle facilities or adjacent bike paths are
22 desirable on higher volume roadways with higher travel speeds; and
23

24 **WHEREAS**, in August 2009, the Village created a Bicycle and
25 Pedestrian plan as a step towards achieving a higher percentage of non-
26 motorized trips by identifying areas in greatest need of bicycle and
27 pedestrian improvements and the portion of SW 82 Avenue from SW 136
28 Street to SW 168 Street was selected as a priority for commuter access;
29 and;

31 **WHEREAS**, the proposed project is identified in the Village FY 2016-
32 2017 Capital Improvements Program (CIP) for implementation in FY 2017-
33 2018 at an estimated cost of \$92,000; and
34

35 **WHEREAS**, it is recommended that the proposed bike lane project be
36 implemented in FY 2016-2017 to coincide with the resurfacing
37 improvements planned along the same segment of and improve

1 connectivity to the new bike lanes designed for construction under the
2 scope of the traffic circle at the intersection of SW 82 Ave. & SW 168 St.;

5 **WHEREAS**, Section 2-175 of the Village of Palmetto Bay Code of
6 Ordinance authorizes the Village Manager to award a contract without
7 sealed bidding upon determination that the purchase meets acceptability
8 criteria and the supplier has a valid contract or purchase order through
9 competitive process by another governmental entity in the state; and
10

11 **WHEREAS**, H&J Asphalt, Inc. is currently providing the Village with
12 roadway resurfacing services via Resolution 16-118 awarded at the
13 November 7, 2016 regular Council meeting; and
14

15 **WHEREAS**, the 4-ft. wide bike lanes on both sides of this roadway
16 will be constructed in coordination with the roadway resurfacing work
17 awarded H & J Asphalt, Inc.; and
18

19 **WHEREAS**, the Village desires to proceed with the bike lane project
20 utilizing the services of H & J Asphalt, Inc. under the piggyback provision.
21

22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND**
23 **VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY, FLORIDA,**
24 **AS FOLLOWS:**


26 **Section 1:** The Village Council hereby authorizes the Village
27 Manager, pursuant to Sec 2-175 of the Code of Ordinance, to piggyback on
28 an existing contract between Miami-Dade County and H & J Asphalt, Inc.
29 under RFQ No. 20150061.

31 **Section 2.** The Village Manager is further authorized to enter into an
32 agreement with H & J Asphalt, Inc. for the construction of four (4) feet wide
33 bike lanes on both sides of SW 82nd Avenue from SW 160th Street to SW
34 168th Street, and to issue a purchase order to H & J Asphalt, Inc. for an
35 amount not to exceed \$60,000.



24 WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County conducted a competitive bidding process for the
25 procurement of roadway resurfacing services and awarded a bid to H & J Asphalt, Inc.; and

27 WHEREAS, Section 2-175 of the Code of Ordinance authorizes the Village Manager to
28 award a contract without sealed bidding upon determination that the purchase meets acceptability
29 criteria and the supplier has a valid contract or purchase order through competitive process by
30 another governmental entity in the state; and

31
32 WHEREAS, after evaluating current paving contracts entered into between neighboring
33 municipalities and contractors, staff is recommending that, pursuant to Sec 2-175 of the Code of
34 Ordinance, the Village "piggyback" on an existing contract between Miami-Dade County and H & J
35 Asphalt, Inc. (RFQ No. 20150061) for roadway resurfacing; and

37 WHEREAS, H&J Asphalt, Inc. has agreed to authorize the Village to piggyback onto the
38 existing contract with Miami-Dade County for roadway resurfacing services in accordance with the
39 same pricing, terms and conditions including lifting manholes, striping, and the installation of
40 reflective pavement markings in FY 16-17 as detailed in the attached contract for Project No.
41 20150061.

43 WHEREAS, Administration recommends that it is in the best interest of the Village
44 contract with H & J Asphalt, Inc. for continued roadway resurfacing and striping services in the
45 Village of Palmetto Bay for an amount not to exceed \$325,000 in FY 2016-2017; and

1 WHEREAS, the Village Manager is respectfully requesting authorization from the Village Council
2 to proceed with execution of a contract with H & J Asphalt, Inc. for roadway resurfacing in FY
3 2016-2017.






