



SMART Implementation Plan Charrettes

Transit supportive land use plays a critical role in the success of major rapid transit investments. The Miami-Dade Transportation Planning Organization (TPO) is now examining this interrelationship to complement the SMART Plan, which is intended to help achieve community goals through integrating transportation land use planning and development of strategies.

Two (2) series of charrettes will be conducted for the South Dade Transitway Corridor, which runs from the Metrorail Dadeland South Station to Florida City (SW 344 Street). The first Charrette series will be conducted in December, which will be interactive planning sessions where the community will collaborate on creating a land use vision for the corridor.

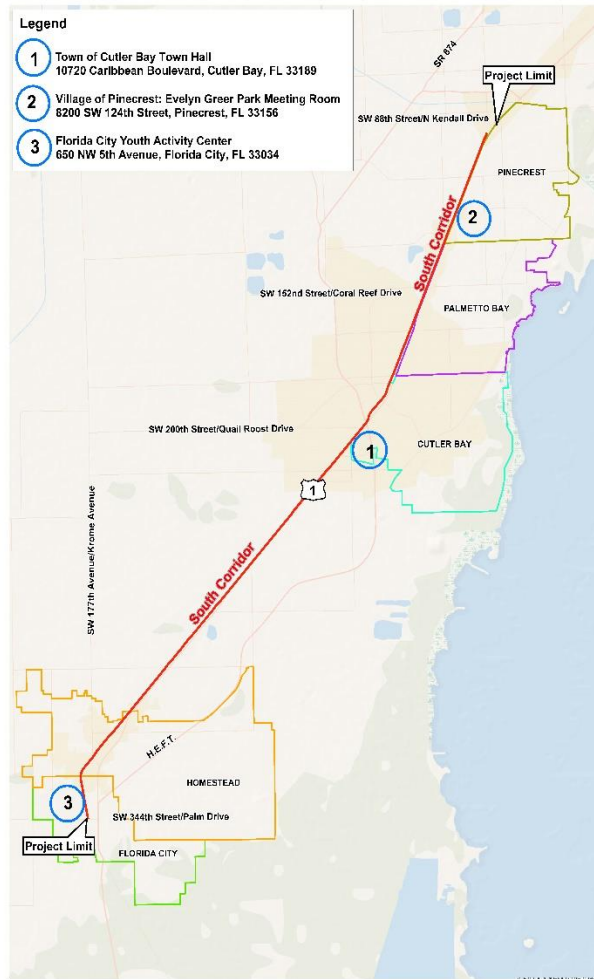
