Re: Extension of Fence Replacement Waiver to May 31, 2018

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**PURPOSE OF THE PROPOSED ACTION:**

The purpose of this memorandum is to direct the Village Manager to waive fence replacement permit fees to May 31, 2018. Hurricane Irma inflicted substantial damage on structures (fences included) within the Village of Palmetto Bay. To date, the immediate need exists for the waiver of fence replacement permit fees due to the damages caused by Hurricane Irma. The extension of fence replacement permit fees will allow residents the opportunity to continue to return their structures to their prior condition without causing them extra costs.

**MAJOR POINTS/REASONS FOR THE PROPOSED ACTION:**

To help expedite fence repairs required because of damage caused by Hurricane Irma, the residents of the Village have expressed the need of waived fence replacement fees. Immediately following Hurricane Irma, the Village Manager was authorized to waive hurricane-related building permit fees to assist residents and commercial business owners in the Village to restore their property and return to normal operations as quickly as possible. Today, the waiver of hurricane related building permit fees has expired, and the immediate need of fence replacements continue to be in demand; therefore, the approval of the proposed action will continue to facilitate recovery efforts from Hurricane Irma.
