21 **WHEREAS,** a pilot program was previously installed by Miami-
22 Dade County at the intersection of SW 136th Street and Old Cutler Road,
23 to limit westbound vehicular access onto SW 136th Street from Old Cutler
24 Road; and,

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26 **WHEREAS,** the county's intent was to make permanent
27 improvements at this intersection following the completion of the pilot
28 program; and,

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30 **WHEREAS,** the temporary blockades are not a permanent solution
31 and are unsightly; and,

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33 **WHEREAS,** the Village Council desire to petition Miami-Dade
34 County to remove the temporary blockades and immediately implement
35 permanent solutions for this unsafe intersection OR as an alternative,
36 allow the Village of Palmetto Bay to implement the solutions through a
37 Joint Participation Agreement.

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39 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND**
40 **THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALMETTO BAY,**
41 **FLORIDA,**

Section 1. The Mayor and Council of the Village of Palmetto Bay hereby petition Miami-Dade County to review existing traffic conditions at the intersection of SW 136th Street and Old Cutler Road and make a final determination on the most appropriate permanent solution to improve the traffic flow and safety at the intersection.


Section 2. The Mayor & Village Council further request that Miami-Dade County remove the temporary blockades installed at the intersection of SW 136 Street and Old Cutler Road, intended as part of a pilot program, and to implement the permanent solutions immediately.

Section 3. The Mayor & Village Council further request that Miami-Dade County implement the permanent solutions immediately, or as an alternative, allow the Village of Palmetto Bay to implement the permanent solutions through a Joint Participation Agreement (JPA) with Miami-Dade County. If the latter is accepted by Miami-Dade County, the Village Manager shall bring the JPA and associated costs before the Village Council for approval.


Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

Re: Traffic blockage on Old Cutler Road and SW 136 street

PURPOSE OF THE PROPOSED ACTION:

The purpose of this memo is to require Miami Dade County to remove the temporary blockade on Old Cutler Road westbound onto SW 136th Street.

MAJOR POINTS/REASONS FOR THE PROPOSED ACTION:

A pilot program was installed by the County at this intersection and they have since then indicated that this will become permanent, however that hasn't happened, and this intersection looks unsightly. We request the County to review the closure of this intersection and if they are to continue with the decision to permanently close it, we request they do so and bring this intersection up to our community standards. If the County is waiting for the redesign of SW 136th Street to improve this intersection we humbly request that a left turn lane be part of the solution to help west bound traffic and provide a better travel access for fire safety equipment.

PRELIMINARY ESTIMATE OF THE COST OF IMPLEMENTATION:

Costs for the approval of this item are to be borne by Miami Dade County.
